

Square in a Square – Using 2 ½” Strips

Makes one 8 ½” (unfinished) block. Make as many as you need.

*** This makes a great block if you contrast the fabrics. Make the center dark and sides light, or make the center light and the sides dark. Make both variations for interest.

CUTTING

For CENTER SQUARE.

Cut (2) 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch squares

For SIDES.

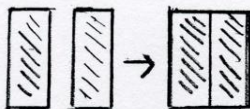
Cut (2) 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch rectangles

For TOP and BOTTOM:

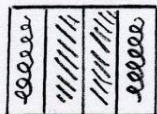
Cut (2) 2 ½ x 8 ½ inch rectangles.

SEWING

Sew two pieces to make center square.



Sew sides to center square. Press seams outward.



Sew top and bottom to piece. Press seams outward.
