
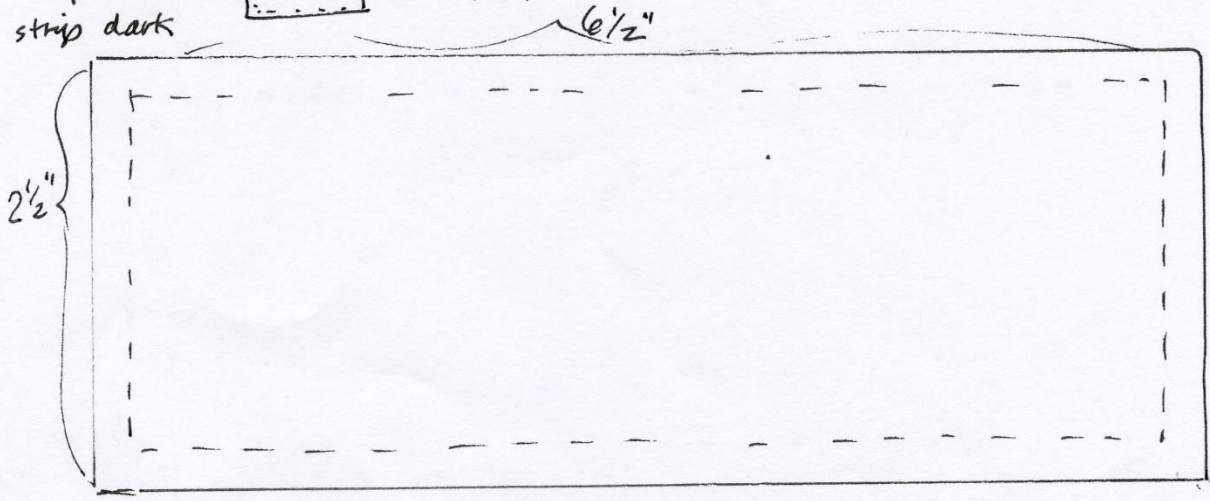



Rail Fence Quilt

FABRIC	STRIP	CUT	TOTAL BLOCKS	QUILT SIZE
1 42" strip light	$2\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ 	3 for 1 block	36	36 1/2" plus borders
1 42" strip medium				
42" strip dark				



- ① Cut length of fabric into long strips $2\frac{1}{2}"$ x length
- ② Cut these strips into pieces $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
- ③ cut 36 $2\frac{1}{2}"$ dark strips
cut 36 $2\frac{1}{2}"$ medium strips
cut 36 $2\frac{1}{2}"$ light strips
- ④ Sew 3 $6\frac{1}{2}"$ strips together in the same color arrangement
the darkest fabric MUST be on an outside edge for zig zag pattern to appear

5. sew  6 blocks together for one row 36" long

- ⑥ Sew five more rows together and join to make a quilt $36\frac{1}{2}" \times 36\frac{1}{2}"$
- ⑦ Add borders, batting + backing + Quilt
